Congresswoman Renee Ellmers

Renee Ellmers was born Feb 9, 1964, in Ironwood, Michigan's Upper Peninsula, and as a child the family moved to Detroit. She attended Oakland University, graduating with a Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing. A year later, while working as a Surgical Intensive Care Nurse at Beaumont Hospital, she met her husband, Brent. After their son, Ben, was born, Renee and her husband decided to move to North Carolina, having relatives in the state. They moved to Dunn, NC, where she worked with her husband as Clinical Director of the Trinity Wound Care Center.

In 2009, she and her husband attended a Town Hall meeting to hear Congressman Bob Etheridge speak about President Obama's health care plan. After that, as a volunteer, she became an outspoken critic of government-run health care, and became involved in politics after the passage of the [Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act](#), which she opposed. She became involved in local Republican politics and joined [Americans for Prosperity](#), a political advocacy group. She sought the Republican Party nomination for Congress in [North Carolina's 2nd congressional district](#), which was then held by seven-term incumbent [Bob Etheridge](#). On election day, November 2, 2010, Renee was declared the winner by the media, but a recount was conducted on November 17 and 18, confirming that she defeated [Bob Etheridge](#) by 1,489 votes, during the general election.

With the 2011 redistricting in NC, we in Moore County are now in District 2, and we have gained Renee Ellmers as our Representative in Congress. The Congresswoman is very active in her job, serving on the Committee on Agriculture and the Committee on Small Businesses, and is Chairwoman of the [Subcommittee on Healthcare and Technology](#).

7 States Will Decide '12 Election

According to Larry Sabato, no matter who wins the Republican presidential nomination, the election results in just seven states will likely decide who gains the 270 electoral votes needed to win the White House next year. Sabato, respected political pundit and director of the Center for Politics at the University of Virginia, says 12 states are locks for President Barack Obama and seven others are likely to go Democrat, so the Democrats have a lead in 19 states for 247 electoral votes.

Meanwhile the Republicans are a lock or lead in 24 states for 206 electoral votes, Sabato observes in an opinion piece in the Wall Street Journal. So seven "super-swing" states with 85 electoral votes will determine who wins the White House — Florida (29 electoral votes), Ohio (18), Virginia (13), Colorado (9), Iowa (6), Nevada (6), and New Hampshire (4). "Prior to Obama's 2008 victories in each of these states, several had generally or firmly leaned Republican since 1980," Sabato writes. "Virginia, which hadn't voted Democrat since 1964, was the biggest surprise, and its Obama majority was larger than that of Ohio.

"Massive Hispanic participation turned Colorado and Nevada to Mr. Obama, and it helped him in Florida."

The GOP has gained an advantage through redistricting following the 2010 Census, with electoral votes from the blue-state Frostbelt moving to the red-state Sunbelt. That could bring the Republican nominee about a half-dozen net electors, according to Sabato, editor of the Crystal Ball newsletter.

But Obama, who is so far unopposed for re-nomination, has the luxury of focusing on the Electoral College and the seven super-swing states, while the GOP contenders need to concentrate much of their efforts on early-voting states including South Carolina, which is already solidly red.

Nevertheless, given the nation's ongoing economic woes and high unemployment, Sabato concludes: "Unexpectedly strong economic growth could make Mr. Obama's re-election path much easier than it currently looks, as could the nomination of a damaged Republican candidate. But a few more weeks like the past couple, and Mr. Obama's re-election trajectory will resemble Jimmy Carter's."

Lieberman: Obama's Fear of Offending Muslims Paralyzes Policy

Speaking at a National Consortium for the Study of Terrorism and Responses to Terrorism conference at the National Press Club, Senator Joe Lieberman said the strategy to stop terror that the president unveiled in June "was ultimately a big disappointment." Obama's plan successfully diagnosed the gravity of domestic radicalization, but failed to lay out a cohesive plan to counter it. One of Lieberman's biggest criticisms, according to a report in [The Hill](#), was that the administration clings to the term "violent extremism" to define the threat to America, rather than identifying it as "[violent Islamist extremism](#)." "The administration still refuses to call our enemy in this war by its proper name: [violent Islamist extremism](#)," said Lieberman, an independent who caucuses with Democrats and chairs the Homeland Security and Government Affairs Committee. "To call our enemy 'violent extremism' is so general and vague that it ultimately has no meaning." (Editor's note: Although an "I", the senator is right on.)
